Anything not listed can be made available upon request. We hope this helps you to make an informed decision about the type of funeral service you may wish to arrange.

Standardised Price List

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors (because prices can vary).

<p>ATTENDED FUNERAL (funeral director's charges only) £1,955</p> <p>This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.</p> <p>Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements £1,100</p> <p>Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (normally within 15 miles of the funeral director's premises) into the funeral director's care £150</p> <p>Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased person will be kept at the funeral director's premises. £150</p> <p>Providing a suitable coffin – this will be made from either a Traditional Oak Veneer or Cardboard at the Clients Choice. £350</p> <p>Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director when we are looking after the funeral arrangements and viewing is requested by the client. £5</p> <p>At a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 20 miles of the funeral director's premises) in a hearse. £200</p>
<p>UNATTENDED FUNERAL</p> <p>This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.</p> <p>Burial (funeral director's charges only) £1,100</p> <p>Cremation (funeral director's charges plus the cremation fee)² £1,490</p>

Fully trained staff to admit the deceased into our care from a local address within twenty miles or a local hospital/care home and initial advice on registration, coroner's procedures and making funeral arrangements.

Carried out by fully trained staff.	
Embalming	On Request
This is carried out by our own Qualified Embalmer subject to the client's permission. This treatment can help to restore a more natural and peaceful appearance to the deceased, but is not obligatory	
Provision of a hearse	£200
The use of a specialist-built hearse, chauffeur driven within a 25-mile radius (additional mileage may be applicable outside this area). This may be from a home address, along a special route or via multiple locations of meaning. For alternative transport such as a horse drawn, motorcycle or Land Rover hearse, please speak to our Funeral Directors for a price on request.	
Provision of each limousine	£200
The use of a specialist vehicle, chauffeur driven within a 25-mile radius (additional mileage may be applicable outside this area). Each limousine seats up to seven people.

- Late payment of the account (14 days) may incur a late payment charge of 1.5% of the balance increasing by a further 1.5% every 30 days thereafter. After 60 days a collection agency will be contracted incurring a 15% + VAT surcharge
